

# Public Works Report December 2017

**Winter Conditions:** Our crew has been hard at work readying and repairing equipment, roads and clubhouses for the winter. Several crewmen have spent many days filling pot holes throughout the community to smooth things up before the deep freeze and ice set in. They have also plowed three storms and come in early many days to sand the bus stops and critical areas and the many miles of ice that forms on our dirt roads due to refreeze even when it is not snowing. They have been doing this shorthanded due to team members being out due to injuries. And winter hasn't even started yet...

**Edge Hill New Water Main:** Our crew has finished installing all the house services. In addition they put the road back together with the graders and added a few inches of new gravel to the top to tighten and smooth it up. That will get us by for the winter until we can give it a final tune up next spring.

**Stolen Plow Equipment Update:** A couple weeks after the first discovery of missing equipment our crew was setting up the last piece of wing plow equipment on our John Deere road grader and discovered one more missing wing arm. That added about another \$800 to the total.

**Water Main Breaks:** Our crew only fixed one break this past month and that was the small one we knew about on Rosemont but had put on the back burner until we got a break in the action.
